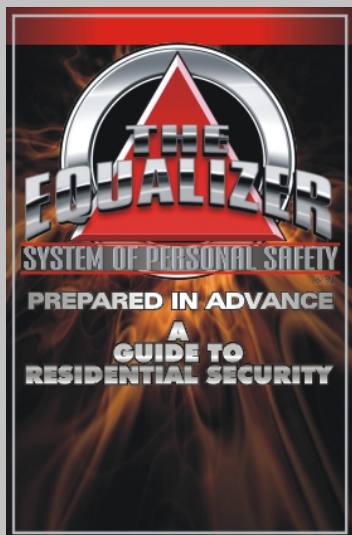

## The Equalizer's Recommended Minimum Security Standards

The Equalizer's Recommended Minimum Security Standards (RMSS) sets the minimum acceptable standards for 15 critical elements of residential security. This includes standards for the status of the physical resistance of a property to criminal attack as well as the status of reliable criminal deterrents employed on the property to avoid criminal attack.
